The Rideways provides wonderful off road riding trails with optional jumps. It is set within tranquil farmland and woodland of Escrick Park Estate, and we hope that you have a wonderful time.

You are however in a working rural environment so please ensure you take full care and attention at all times and follow the terms and conditions.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP AND RIDEWAYS USE

Health and Safety

A first aid kit is located at the Estate Office (building with a tower near parking point).

Approved hard hats and body protectors must be worn when riding and riders are advised to ride in pairs.

Riders under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Walkers are not allowed on the course due to Health & Safety reasons.

All riders using the obstacles must be of a competent riding ability and all horses must be healthy and of sound condition and able to deal with the demands of the course.

Mobile phones must be carried for contact with the Estate team or emergencies services if required.

Riders are asked to please report any accidents, damage to any jumps or other property on the Estate, to enable us to keep up our standards of health & safety and careful maintenance.

Although we have attempted to make the course as safe as possible, Escrick Park Estate cannot be held responsible for any damage or injury to riders, horses, or their property. We recommend that riders inspect jumps at all times prior to attempting the obstacle.

Cyclists and Dogs

Cyclists are not allowed on the course. However, we allow ONE cyclist to accompany a lone rider for £25 fee which can be added with day ride online booking.

Dogs are not allowed on the course but may walk with owners to the folly and back under close control. (1 mile walk).

Parking & Directions

Rideways tracks are signed by green markers (Cross country course) or blue arrows (extended hacking). Please follow these tracks carefully and respect the Country Code. No deviations from these routes are permitted.

Horse boxes and vehicles are parked at owners own risk.

Ticketing and Course Opening Times

There is no refund for cancellations, however, please reschedule before your allotted time at no extra cost.

Please carry your day ticket at all times when riding on the Rideways. Any person found riding the course without their day ticket will be asked to leave immediately and may be prosecuted. Please do not abuse these facilities.

Escrick Park Estate staff and Rideways stewards have the right to ask all riders for identification at any time.

The course is open every day. We do however, reserve the right to close any parts or all of the course due to poor conditions, or to ensure rider's safety during other events.

Escrick Park Estate will hire out the course to various events, clubs, and groups, including carriage driving events. A full list of event dates may be obtained from The Estate Office or view the website News tab.

Shooting

Shooting takes place around the Estate from time to time throughout the year. To avoid upset when you hear shooting or see the shooting party, please either change course or wait until the shooting party moves on and it is safe to continue. Regretfully it is impossible to advise members of the exact location of the shooting although dates can be issued on request.

Reservations

Anyone found not to be following these terms and conditions, or not to have not paid their fee will be asked to leave the course immediately.
